- Major Cancer

- Heart Attack-of specified severity
- Severe Cardiomyopathy
- Infective Endocarditis
- Coronary Artery By-Pass Surgery
- Heart Valve Replacement or Repair

- Thoracic or Abdominal Aorta Surgery

- Stroke - resulting in permanent neurological deficit with persisting clinical symptoms
- Bacterial Meningitis
- Severe Encephalitis
- Benign Brain Tumour
- Brain Surgery

- Late-Stage Lung Failure
- Primary Pulmonary Hypertension

- Late-Stage Liver Failure
- Fulminant Hepatitis

- Late-Stage Kidney Failure
